The Big Ideas


- What happened in the past was **much, much** more violent than the present by over a 100,000 times




These are in plain view. When you look at a folded rock, a bent layer of shale, even the sand we walk on in Los Osos, remind yourself how it got there. The whole state of California's existence owes itself to the aftermath of the Great Deluge. It is the debris pile washing westward off North America as the Flood ended:

He established the earth upon its foundations, So that it will not totter forever and ever. You covered it with the deep as with a garment; The waters were standing above the mountains. At Your rebuke they fled, At the sound of Your thunder they hurried away. The mountains rose; the valleys sank down To the place which You established for them. – Psalm 104:5–8



Now, having just seen the enormous eruption of Mt. Helens, compare these containers. The left 5-gallon bucket represents the amount of ash given off by one of hundreds of volcanoes during the Flood. Which container represents the ash spewed by Mt. St. Helens?



The Richter scale, old school, was replaced by the Moment Magnitude Scale that more accurately measures the energy of an earthquake at depth, as opposed to the surface only measurement of the good old Richter, which A) only is accurate for mag 8 or less, and B) we're going way north of mag 8!

Using the Richter scale difference in 1 mag represents 31 times as much energy as the one below it (A mag 4.4 is has 31 times energy than a 3.4) It measures moment instead of just amplitude. It also measures how much things are moved around in other directions.
